



Privacy Notice

The Irish Patchwork Society (hereinafter referred to as the Society) has as aims the following:

- To promote the practice and art of patchwork, applique and quilting (hereinafter referred to as quiltmaking) in Ireland
- To foster and encourage communication between persons interested in traditional and contemporary quiltmaking
- To promote lectures, workshops, exhibitions and other activities of interest to quilt makers
- To publish a newsletter and to encourage publication of the aims and activities of the Society
- To encourage education in and to raise and maintain standards of quiltmaking in Ireland
- To research and set up a typographical and photographic archive

To achieve these aims it is necessary to collect personal data from our members, visitors, and those involved in the promotion of the Society and the Society's aims.

What information do we collect about you?

We collect personal information from you when you register as a member, attend a branch meeting, participate in a Society event (workshop/AGM/AnGrianan etc.), enter an exhibition, receive payments online through Bank of Ireland Business Online or access our additional online services, GroupSpaces (for Executive Committee members) and www.IrishPatchwork.com through Wild Apricot Association Management Software. Website usage information may be collected using Cookies.

How will we use the information about you?

We collect information about you to process your membership application, communicate with you and manage your membership account. Information provided on exhibition entry forms is used to create signage and exhibition catalogues. Your information is shared with our postal service to deliver your newsletter and bank details may be shared with Bank of Ireland to process online payments e.g. for reimbursement of expenses or deposits.

Marketing

Your information may be used for promoting the Society on Social Media (Facebook, branch blogs, Society Website etc.), at exhibitions, Society events and branch meetings (e.g. Open Days) and in our Newsletter.

Access to your own information and correction

You have the right to request a copy of the information that we hold about you. If you would like a copy of your personal information, please email or write to us at the address below. We may make a small charge for this service.
